Cal-OES Salary Survey/Admin. Rate Resolution #429

Background: Annually the fire department is required submit a cost allocation plan to the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal-OES) with a resolution from the Board or Directors.

Department: Fire Department

Discussion: As part of the cost reimbursement process with Cal-OES, fire departments are required to submit a cost allocation plan, in resolution form, approved by the Board of Directors. This is done on an annual basis.

Financial Impact: At the conclusion of this process the department will receive reimbursement for suppression and/or Incident Management Support Division members and recover administrative costs for responses within the parameters of the California Fire Assistance Agreement (CFAA). This is a financial benefit to the department.

Recommendation: Recommend approval of the cost allocation plan, resolution #429.
